

Glenlivet Estate Woodland Week



The annual woodland week for schools will be held on the Glenlivet Estate between 5th and 9th June 2006. As usual a range of forest based activities will be available for primary schools including guided walks, demonstrations of forestry machinery, with information about forest management and wildlife. This event is usually hugely popular with schools from both the local area and elsewhere in Moray. This year we have schools booked from Grantown on Spey to Elgin.

The day begins with a slide show concentrating on the various aspects of forestry management and the wildlife on the Estate followed by tree recognition. The groups are then taken to the forest where they watch a harvesting operation and a chainsaw demonstration, participate in a scavenger hunt collecting cones, leaves and offcuts from the chainsaw demonstration. When the group return to the office they have the opportunity to play on the Adventure Playground next to the Estate Office and Information Centre.

Although the Woodland Week only runs for 5 days group visits with the Ranger service are available throughout the year.
