Workshop will be held at Glenlivet Estate Office and Information Centre in Tomintoul on 15th July 2010 10am- 1pm

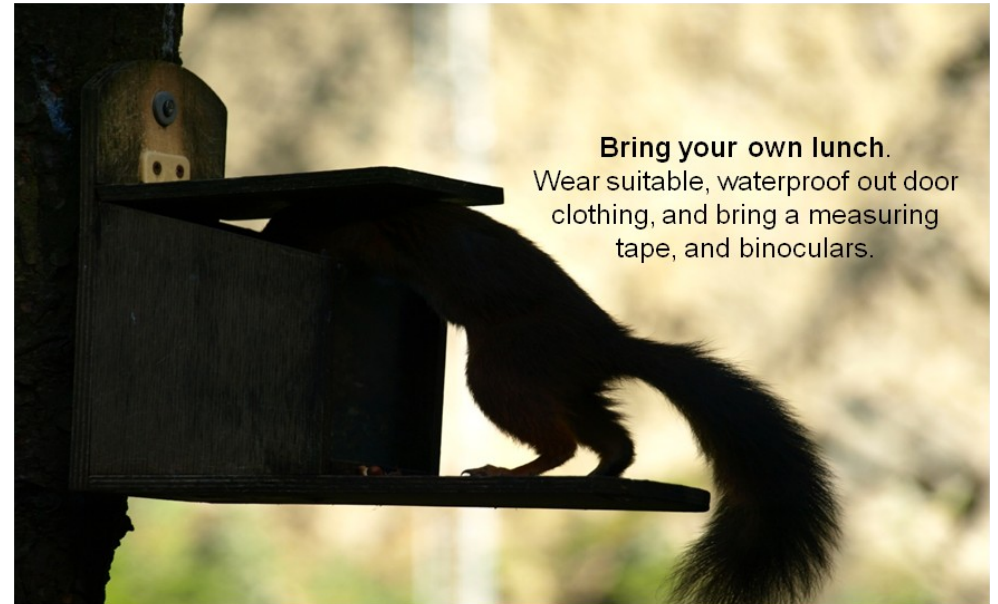
The workshop will cover:
